The Universidad Adolfo Ibáñez (UAI) is a private, non-profit institution established as such in 1988. It originates from the Valparaíso Business School, founded in 1953 by the Adolfo Ibáñez Foundation, which preserves the legacy of businessman and public figure Adolfo Ibáñez Boggiano.

Currently, the Universidad Adolfo Ibáñez has 8 faculties offering 12 undergraduate programs, more than 10,000 undergraduate students, and over 2,000 postgraduate students. The university also offers 62 master's programs and 8 doctoral programs.

The UAI operates on two main campuses: one in Peñalolén (Santiago) and another in Viña del Mar. Additionally, all executive postgraduate programs are held at the Vitacura and Presidente Errázuriz locations (Las Condes).

For the GETM4 Project there are three main directions that are involved: International Relations Office, Research Direction and the Innovation & Transference Direction.
