An identification code will be sent to the partner university at the end of February each year.

Which courses ?

- Courses in **English** and in **French**
- A full track in **English** is possible
- **Undergraduate** level courses in economics and management and **Master** level courses in economics
- Possibility to select courses from other disciplines

Workload

- A normal workload represents **30 ECTS** per semester.
- 1 course of 5 ECTS represents on average 30 contact hours.
- We expect you to have a workload comparable to the one you would be required to have at your home university.

French language courses

French courses for foreigners are organized by the Institut des Langues Vivantes (ILV) from beginner to advanced level.

Housing information

Finding accommodation is the student's responsibility.
We recommend you start searching as soon as you are nominated.

Student accommodation on campus is available for students.

They can choose between:

- University Housing (LOGE - UCLouvain accommodation office)
- Privately-owned accommodation

University Housing is limited.

Students should apply as soon as possible.

- Applications from Mar. 31st until Jul. 31th for Fall Term
- Applications from Jul. 31st until Nov. 30th for Spring Term

Students considering private housing on campus in Louvain-la-Neuve should be cautious about potential scams.

It's essential not to transfer money to landlords before physically inspecting the property or obtaining verifiable proof of legitimacy.

Stay vigilant to avoid falling victim to fraudulent schemes.



Living costs and practical information

Average monthly rent for UCLouvain accommodation (a room) is 295 euros.

Average rent for privately-owned accommodation is between 600 and 800 euros for a one-bedroom flat, and between 750 and 900 euros for a two-bedroom flat.
